Dear Families,

As you may have heard, many things are changing daily with new guidelines surrounding the COVID-19 pandemic. For instance, it is now recommended that if you are positive you only quarantine for five days from the onset of symptoms or test positive, whichever is first, and that your symptoms are improving without a temperature for 24 hours.

In addition, we no longer require a COVID-19 test from your pediatrician or healthcare provider because the County and State are accepting home tests. (The school will provide these as long as our supplies last). If your home test is positive, please contact Nurse Aurilio and she will guide you through the process of reporting to the County. If your child is negative, please keep your child home until their symptoms are resolved and are fever-free for 24 hours. It is still important to let Nurse Aurilio know if your child had a negative test result.

We are still asking parents to make sure they keep their child(ren) home if they are showing symptoms. You can call the school and pick up a home test kit if you would like.
