Principal's Picnic

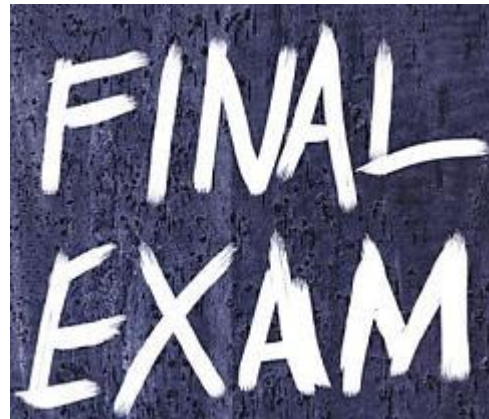
End Of Year Picnic

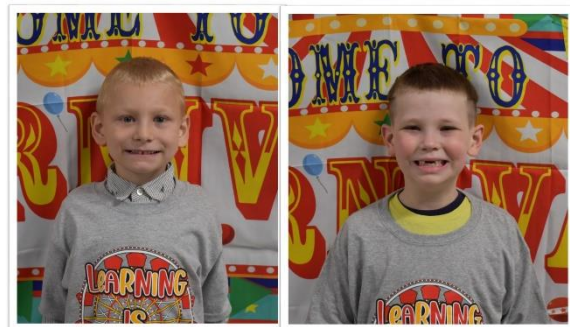

Johnsburg Families,

The end of the school year is almost here! Thank you for your patience and understanding as we've worked together to get to the end of this year. I hope you have a healthy summer!

We have all seen how many times COVID-19 regulations have changed; it is likely to do so again before the next school year. We will be sure to communicate the most up-to-date information before the start of the school year this fall. Stay tuned!

I mailed letters to several families whose students will be due for physicals before the next school year. If you received a letter for your child, please schedule those physicals as soon as possible; the summer goes quicker than you think. Especially if your child is planning to play a fall sport (grades 7-12), which starts mid to late August, they will not be able to participate if their physical is not up to date. I also mailed letters to students needing vaccines for the next school year. These vaccines are required within 14 days of the start of the school year, meaning by September 20th; otherwise, school exclusion is required by NYS.

* Reminder: Religious exemptions are no longer acceptable.

All paperwork can still be dropped off or faxed over the summer. I would encourage you to be proactive and hand it in once completed.

If your child has medications at school, please contact me to schedule a time to pick them up by June 23rd unless they will be attending summer school. All medications will be discarded if not picked up.

Remember that ALL medication orders expire at the end of every school year, so if your child needs daily or as-needed medications at school for next year, please be diligent in obtaining those orders before day one of the next school year.

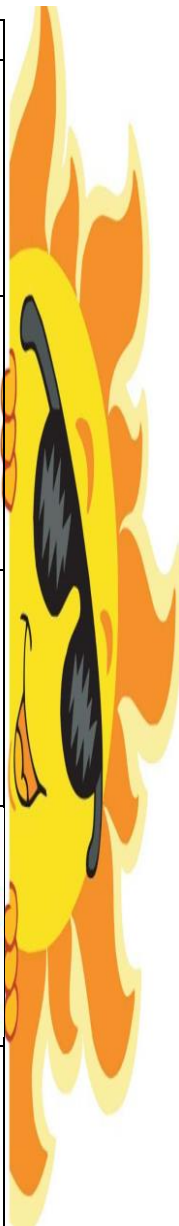


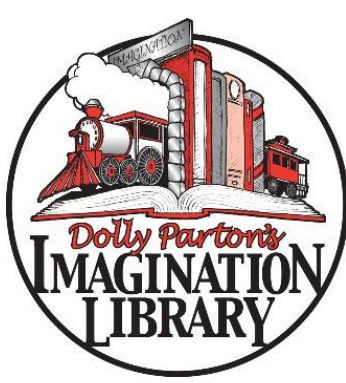

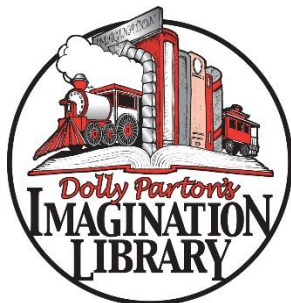

Incoming Prekindergarten at JCS

If your child(ren) will be 4 years old prior to December 1, 2022, they are eligible to attend prekindergarten during the 2022-2023 school year. Please call Laurie West in the main office at 518-251-2921 to register your child for pre-k. After you call, you will be sent a packet of information to fill out and return to the guidance office. Your child will be placed on a list indicating whether you prefer an AM or PM session, if it becomes necessary to have two sessions of pre-k. We cannot guarantee that your child will be placed in the session that you prefer. Placement will be determined by a first come, first-served basis. Please fill out and return your packets as soon as possible.

Incoming Kindergarten at JCS

If your child(ren) will be 5 years old prior to December 1, 2022, they are eligible to attend kindergarten during the 2022-2023 school year. If your child currently attends pre-k at JCS, your child will be automatically registered for kindergarten. If your child is not currently enrolled in pre-k at JCS, please call Laurie West in the main office at 518-251-2921 as soon as possible.
