Items for Discussion and/or Action:

Presentation: Music: Katy Ashe and Max Garrett spoke of the time-line

of the music department from COVID to now. A handout was provided. Both departments spoke of the cost of maintaining and servicing the instruments and stated their budget funds are not enough to cover all costs. Sarah Williams and Tom Ordway were willing to look at more financial support. Sarah Williams suggested a booster club for some additional revenue. Tom Ordway made a **MOTION** to approve a school bus for occasional field trips for the Town of Johnsburg Youth Program for the summer of 2022, with the understanding they will be responsible for the cost of the driver and the use of the bus, seconded by Sarah Williams.

Mike Markwica stated the Youth Program will follow the 8-11:30 Summer School schedule. The Monday field trips (bus use and driver)will be the Youth Commissions financial responsibility. MOTION carried.

Tom Ordway made a **MOTION** to approve the HVAC Capital Improvement Project Proposal from Tetra Tech for \$969,000, utilizing the Federal Stimulus funds, seconded by Sarah Williams and carried.

Tom Ordway made a **MOTION** to approve the 2022 Building Condition Survey presented by Tetra Tech, seconded by Sarah Williams. Mike Markwica explained that every five years a building condition survey is done. He also stated that Tetra Tech was less expensive than other bids. He went on to say this survey will be conducted in the fall of 2022.

Committee Reports:

Sports Merger Committee: There will be a Fall kick-off on August 18, 2022. The Committee also spoke of improving communication between the two schools and working on the uniform supply issues.

Updates:

Mike Markwica stated that there was a lot going on this time of year: music, National Honor Society, sports. It's a very busy time.
